


Three prevalent models

- The "equip" model
 - Empty sacks
 - Oasis in the desert
 - "Inside and Out"

The "attract" model

- Worship is the place of ministry, mission, evangelism
- "Outside in"
- Both "equip" and "attract" assume a significant disconnect between church and world

• The "do" model

- A rehearsal of God's story
- A microcosm of the daily life
- The performance of God's story as the Church for the World the world done right.

Church and Culture

- Relationship of church to culture is an *exchange*...both produce this performance.
 - Inculturation
- Inculturation calls for a nuanced middle of two extremes:
 - First extreme: the church has a culture that is different from the world
 - Second extreme: the church must mimic the culture in order to attract and gain relevance
 - Nuanced middle: The Church is the "World done right."

Doing the world: Using, redeeming, and being culture

- The Gospel transforms culture
 - All culture is redeemable!
- Culture (rituals) create meaning
 - Culture *is not neutral*.
 - It is not that we are doing rituals, rituals are doing us.
